Remarkable	/ rɪ 'mɑ: kəbl /	Unusual or surprising in a way that causes people to take notice
Irresponsible	/ ,ɪrɪ 'spɒnsəbl /	Not showing a feeling of responsibility
Outrageous	/ aʊt 'reɪdʒəs /	Offensive and unacceptable
Nasty	/ 'nɑ: stɪ /	Very bad or unpleasant
Memorable	/ 'memərəbl /	Worth remembering or easy to remember, especially because of being special or unusual
Delightful	/ dɪ 'laɪtfl /	Very pleasant
Hilarious	/ hɪ 'leəriəs /	Extremely funny
Terrifying	/ 'terɪfaɪɪŋ /	Making somebody feel extremely frightened
Fascinating	/ 'fæsɪneɪtɪŋ /	Extremely interesting and attractive
Intriguing	/ ɪn 'trɪ: gɪŋ /	Very interesting because of being unusual or not having an obvious answer
Exhausting	/ ɪg 'zɔ: stɪŋ /	Making you feel very tired
Filthy	/ 'fɪlθi /	Very dirty and unpleasant
Packed	/ pækt /	Extremely full of people
Extravagant	/ ɪk 'strævəgənt /	Very extreme or impressive but not reasonable or practical
